

# Seminar:

# High Performance Micro-silica Concrete for Marine and Harbour Applications



he Technical Committee of ACI-Kuwait Chapter in collaboration with Alghanim Specialties Company WLL organised and held a seminar under the above title. It was presented by Robert Lewis, the Technical Manager for Elkem Materials-Norway.

The Seminar was prompted with an opening statement by Eng. Mr. Khalifa Al-Fadhalah. In his statement Eng. Al-Fadhalah presented an abridged profile of Alghanim Specialties Company.

Dr. Moetaz El-Hawary gave a short over view of ACI Kuwait Chapter and its activities and introduced the Speaker Mr. Robert Lewis. The speaker maintained that, the durability of the structure depends not only on the durability of the concrete, but also on all aspects of the design and the workmanship. Creation of mixes containing micro-silica to various proportions and the use of various blends of different types of cement can result in the desired overall concrete quality.

Ifthedesignandworkmanshipofmicrosilica concrete are handled properly, the desired long term durability and service life can be achieved with: Dense Microstructure, Low Permeability, Improved Resistance to Chloride Ion Penetration, Increased Electrical Resistivity, Improved

Resistance to: Chemical Attack, Abrasion and Erosion, Frost and Scaling, Alkali-Aggregate Reactions, Sulfate Attack and Steel Corrosion Resistance.

At the end of the seminar there was a general discussion during which Mr. Lewis responded to various questions.

The Seminar was held at Alghanim Specialties Company auditorium Shuwaikh on Sunday 7th Feb. 2010.

# Seminar: Sustainability and Low Carbon Concrete



AS part of ongoing activities, The Technical Committee of the ΛCI Kuwait Chapter organized and conducted a SAMINAR under the title of "Sustainability and Low Carbon Concrete"

Prof. Moetaz El-Hawary addressed the issue of energy efficient buildings and the embodied energy of buildings which accounts for 16% of the total carbon footprint over its service life...

In his lecture Prof. El-Hawary stressed the necessity of proper design, concrete selection and that of building materials which are essential energy conservation tools to reduce this percentage. He added that, Cement manufacturing is one of the most energy consuming industries. Each tone of cement clinker releases 0.9 tons of CO2.

In this presentation, different methods and techniques that may be adapted to reduce the embodied energy percentage - and hence carbon emission were discussed.



hindering the required progress, by necessity, of concrete industry as the For example, until the beginning of this movement towards the adoption, in standards for specifying concrete, and secondary aggregates (including

in structural concrete. He argues strongly a case for breaking out of this straitjacket and instead adopting a responsible shift towards performance-based approach to concrete design and construction. This will allow the much needed flexibility in concrete design and enable concrete to respond to the demands of changing world, such as, (i) climate change, (ii) carbon footprint, (iii) economic pressures, (iv) client pressures, (v) increasing demands from building insurance and (vi) high performance concrete requirements.

Professor Dhir stresses that to ensure that concrete emerges as the sustainable solution beneficial to construction world over, will require a well focused, coordinated and visionary approach across all communities within the concrete industry.

The Seminar was held at the Kuwait Society of Engineers on Tuesday 22nd December, 2009.




Behbehani Steel Factory


Site visit



# FIRST RING ROAD SITE VISIT


